1. Logging into the TMP is the same as logging into DataNose. The TMP is hosted on DataNose 2.0 and so the URL is different (datanose.uva.nl will eventually replace the existing datanose.nl). This means you will be required to use the Tigr 2FA app in order to log in.
2. Once you log into the TMP, you will be directed to your group/department's page. Here you can see your group's name, website, and other details. If the description and/or website is missing, please click on the button labelled "Edit Organisation Profile", which is located in the upper right-hand corner, and fill in the missing information.
